



WELLNESS GUIDELINES

We ask that you do not bring a child to church that appears to be ill. This is for the protection of your child as well as the other children. A warm welcome awaits your child once he or she has been free of the following symptoms for the last 24 hours:

- Fever of 100 or above, vomiting, diarrhea, sore throat, croup
- Any unexplained rash
- Pink eye or other eye infection
- Common cold, from onset through one week
- Any skin infection: boils, ringworm, impetigo
- Any symptoms of childhood disease such as scarlet fever, German measles, mumps, chickenpox, or whooping cough

If your child develops a fever or other symptoms of illness while he or she is in an Ingleside Preschool Ministry class, he or she will be isolated, and you will be contacted.

If your child develops an infectious disease (measles, mumps, chicken pox, etc.) following a session in the Ingleside Preschool Ministry, please contact the office immediately at preschool@ingleside.org or 478.477.0600.

All medication must be administered by a parent.

Communicate any allergies your child has when you arrive.

We request that you use disposable diapers at church. This helps eliminate the spread of germs. Cloth diapers and soiled clothing will not be rinsed out and will be returned to you in a plastic bag.
