**If I am a follower of Jesus, I can always give thanks for . . .**

**1. The \_\_\_\_\_ of God that \_\_\_\_\_ me.**

*For by grace you have been saved* through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God,<sup>9</sup> not a result of works, so that no one may boast.<sup>10</sup> For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. (Ephesians 2:8-10, ESV)

- \_\_\_\_\_ **grace** – he chose me before the foundation of the world (Ephesians 1:4)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **grace** – he purchased my pardon through the blood of Jesus (Ephesians 1:7)
- \_\_\_\_\_ **grace** – he will sustain me and see me all the way home (2 Corinthians 12:9)

2. The \_\_\_\_\_ of God to always be \_\_\_\_\_  
me and never to \_\_\_\_\_ me.

I am with you always, to the end of the age. (Matthew 28:20b, ESV)

for he has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." <sup>6</sup> So we can confidently say, "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me?" (Hebrews 13:5b-6, ESV)

3. The \_\_\_\_\_ God has designed for me.

For I know *the plans I have for you*, declares the LORD, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope. (Jeremiah 29:11, ESV)

And we know that for those who love God *all things work together for good*, for those who are called according to his purpose. (Romans 8:28, ESV)

4. The \_\_\_\_\_ God is making in me.

Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, <sup>4</sup> and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, (Romans 5:3-4, ESV)

Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, <sup>3</sup> for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. <sup>4</sup> And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing. (James 1:2-4, ESV)

5. The \_\_\_\_\_ God is preparing for me.

"Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. <sup>2</sup> In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? <sup>3</sup> And if I go and *prepare a place for you*, I will come again and will take you to myself, that *where I am you may be also*. (John 14:1-3, ESV)
