GO Week is a local mission opportunity here in Macon, where Ingleside's Middle School Ministry and High School Ministry partner together to serve our community and go with the gospel. Students will serve and share the gospel with our community through various ministry sites during the week. Past ministry projects have included Bible Schools at apartment complexes, Habitat for Humanity, Rebuilding Macon, Brookdale Warming Center, The Rescue Mission Bargain Center, Pinegate Retirement Home, John Wesley Villas, prayer walks, and serving at the Church Picnic. Students will also receive evangelism training and will worship together throughout the week.

GO Week FAQs

Why should my student participate in missions?

In order to help students be faithful followers of Jesus, we provide opportunities for them to come to worship, grow in a group, serve in the body, and go with the gospel. GO Week is one way for students to live out an important part of discipleship (Matthew 28:19-20, Acts 1:8). Your student will be stretched spiritually, physically, and emotionally but will experience God's wider work in our community. GO Week provides your student with an amazing opportunity to meet the practical needs of others and share the good news of the gospel.

What's the first step for my student to be involved in GO Week?

The first step is to register your student online at ingleside.org/register and pay the \$40 cost. Next, have your student fill out a Student Missions Application if they have not done so before. These applications are available online at ingleside.org/go. Next, make sure that your student is aware of the upcoming Student Membership Classes and Student Missions Orientations if needed.

Who is GO Week for?

GO Week is open to all Middle School students (6th-8th grade) and High School students (9th-12th grade) who can demonstrate a testimony of faith in Christ and fulfill the requirements listed on the front page.

Can my student recruit a guest outside of Ingleside to go?

No. All of our Ingleside mission trips require participants to be active members of our local fellowship.

What is the tentative daily schedule?

GO Week begins Sunday, June 23, at 2:00 p.m. Students will gather at Across the Street (ATS) for orientation, mission team project preparation, evangelism training, dinner, and prayer. Students will need to be picked up at ATS at 8:00 p.m. Sunday evening. The tentative daily schedule will be as follows for Monday through Thursday:
